International Camp and Technical Qualifications

The AAKF 60th National Championships will be preceded by a 3-day International Camp conducted in conjunction with Judges' seminar.

The International camp will emphasize Traditional Budo Principles, Fundamentals and Applications. As in all AAKF camps, training is designed to improve the technical understanding of karatekas of all ranks and ages, for competing and non-competing athletes and cover all aspects of training (*kata, kumite, kogo, enbu*). There will be an examination for *dan* and *kyu* rank, ranking examiner, Judge's qualification and coaching qualification on Thursday 6/22 or Friday 6/23/2023. **All examinees are required to take part in all three days of training.** For more information regarding the qualification requirements please visit the following links:

There is no specific age or rank requirement for Synchronized Kata or Enbu team members. The teams may include members of various ages, ranks and genders.

Adult Kyu Ranking Championship (18 year old and above, 8th Kyu and above).

Competitor Requirements

- Each Participant must be a registered 2023 AAKF individual member and belong to a club that is a 2023 AAKF registered member
- Each Youth National participant must be between 6 and 17 years of age and hold a rank of 8th Kyu or above
- Each Adult National participant must have a Black Belt ranking
- Each Adult National Competitor must be 18 years of age or older
- Each Adult National Competitor participating in Kumite or Fuku-go must be between 18 and 54 years of age.

What to bring

Average June temperatures are in the mid 80s. Most places are temperature controlled but be prepared to stay hydrated outdoors as well as during training and competition. The Washington DC area is humid in the summer months.
